CCZ Grand Round:

Radio-Onkologie und andere Systeme der Gesellschaft im Wandel seit 1970



Prof. Dr. med. Christoph Glanzmann Konsiliarius Universitätsspital Zürich

It is our pleasure to announce the farewell lecture of Prof. Christoph Glanzmann.

Prof Glanzmann studied medicine at the University of Heidelberg and graduated in 1967. He had already developed multiple interests at this time, underlined by the fact that he undertook a research fellowship in pharmacology at the University of Freiburg, followed by post-graduate studies in mathematics and physical chemistry at the University of Tübingen.

He joined the University Hospital Zürich (USZ) in 1971 as a resident working in nuclear medicine, radiation oncology and radio- diagnostics and became an Oberarzt in 1974. In 1981, he moved to the Department of Radiation Oncology and Nuclear Medicine at the Ospedale San Giovanni, Bellinzona, where he became vice-chairman of the department in 1982 and remained in that position for over 5 years. In 1987, the new chairman of the USZ – Professor Urs Lütolf – invited Professor Glanzmann to return to the USZ as vice chairman of the Department of Radiation Oncology. Professor Glanzmann remained clinically active at the USZ until 2006 and continued beyond the 'regular retirement period' in his current role as a consultant to the Department of Radiation Oncology. During this time, he provided much appreciated clinical and planning expertise to more than a generation of his junior colleagues.

Academically, Professor Glanzmann completed his MD in 1968 at the University of Heidelberg, attained his Privat Dozent at the University of Zürich, Faculty of Medicine in 1976 and became a Professor of Radiation Oncology (Extraordinarius, member of the medical faculty) in 1991. In 2006, he was awarded the Zuppinger Medal for his contribution to the field of radiation oncology by the Bernese Radiumstiftung.

Professor Glanzmann demonstrates many exceptional qualities beyond his medical and scientific expertise. He is not only appreciated for his encyclopedic knowledge of radiation oncology over the past 4 decades, but all aspects of medicine, mathematics, philosophy and numerous other subjects beyond the realm of medicine. His multiple interests are highlighted by the title of his farewell lecture, which will no doubt be a tour de force of evidence based knowledge and creative thinking.
